Duluth Model DAIP

The **DAIP Program**, based on the **Duluth Model**, is a 26-week court-approved domestic violence intervention course. It focuses on accountability, education, and behavior change for individuals who have used violence or control in intimate relationships. Through group sessions, participants learn to recognize abusive patterns, take responsibility for their actions, and develop healthier, non-violent relationship skills.
